## A. Proposed Establishment ... (cont'd)

- 6.3. Recipients-who fail to comply with the terms of the fellowship and those whose grants are terminated for cause during the grant period shall return the full amount received. They shall also be subject to such other sanctions prescribed by pertinent University rules. Furthermore, they shall be disqualified from all university grants.
- 7. Intellectual Property Rights

Publications and other outputs produced in the course of or as a result of the fellowships shall be bound by University policy on Intellectual Property Rights.<sup>1</sup>

# Board action: Approval

B. Proposal to amend the BOR approved incentive of System and Campus level officials of financial assistance for their annual executive check-up at PGH to give the same incentive for check up done in other Government Hospitals

## Background

On 25 July 2002, during the 1161<sup>st</sup> Meeting of the Board of Regents, one of the approved incentives for

# **B.** Proposal to amend the BOR ... (cont'd)

Faculty Administrators is financial assistance of up to P10,000.00 for the annual executive check up at the Philippine General Hospital, to be provided by the CU for campus level officials and by the System for system officials.

The incentive is limited to having the annual executive check up only in the Philippine General Hospital.

### Rationale

Officials from CU's outside Metro Manila would be spending for their transportation and accommodation when they undergo executive check-up in PGH, inasmuch as the CU would just pay a maximum of P10,000.00 to PGH.

Some officials might find it more convenient to have their check up in a government hospital near their place of work or residence. Limiting the hospital to just PGH might be a disincentive to some officials.

### Proposal

It is hereby proposed that system (to include the members of the Board of Regents) and campus level officials be allowed to have their executive check up done in any government hospitals including PGH and still get the same financial assistance of up to P10,000.00 payable to the hospital.

An agreement/understanding with Government hospitals shall be made in order to facilitate admission of U.P. officials for executive check up and payment of hospital bills by the University.
