i. To define the standards, consistent with Colleqe and University criteria, and aporove suitable mechanisms for the evaluation of individual faculty performance:
j. To define the sṭandards, consistent with College and University criteria. and approve suitable mechanisms for the evaluation of Institute or Department berforiance in teaching, research, extension, and other relevant activities;
k. To nominate candidates for Professorial Chairs, unless it decides to deleqate this nower to an Institute or Department academic Dersonnel committee; and

1. To evaluate the records and recommend the graduation of students enrolled in the curricular proorans of the Institute or Dopartinent.

ART. A. The recommendations of the Institute or Denartment Facultr concerming the institution revision and abolition of curricular, research, and extension programs may be revierjed by the College Faculty Assembly.

ART. 5. The Institute or Department shall be headed by a Director or Chairman, resnectively, whose role shall be that of academic leader and administrator to be aprointed by the chancellor for a term of three (3) years: nrovided, that the Directors of nation 2 institutes shall he apoointed by the president.

Anr. 6. The functions of the Director or Chairman shall be:
a. To draft the overall Institute or Department plan and annual progran?
b. To exercise general sunervision over all curricular and research programs, extension services
and other related activities of the Institute or Department:
c. To represent the Institute or Department in the College Executive Board;
d. To appoint an Assistant to the Director or Chairman: nrovided, that the Institute or Department has twenty: five (25) or more regular members and/or one hundred (100) student majors: provided, further, that another Assistant may be appointed if the Institute or Department has fifty (50) or more regular members and/or two hundred (200) student majors,
e. To determine the agenda and preside over meetings of the Institute or Department Faculty provided, that upon the reçuest of a majority of the Institute or Department Faculty: the Institute Director or Departmont Chairman shall also call a meeting and discuss its agenda:
f. To create committees, anoint members thereto, and supervise their work: provided that the members of the Institute or Denartment academic personnel committee shall be chosen by the Institute or DepartRent Faculty?
g. To take the necessary steps to assist and expedite the thesis work of graduate students;
h. To expeditiously act upon and/or transmit faculty decisions from the Institute or Department to the proper University authorities:
i. To approve requests for substitution of courses:
j. To sunervise and evaluate the work of the Institute"s or Department's research, extension and orofessional staff (REPS), and administrative nersonnel.
3. To assume resmonsibility for the procurement and allocation of supplies; materials, and equinment, and the maintenance of Institute or Denartment facilities?

1. To assume responsibility for all Institute or Department publications; and
m. To draft the Institute's or Department's annual renort for presentation to the Institute or Derjartment Faculty.

ART. 7. If an urgent matter arises which is not covered by the quidelines nromulgated by the Institute or Department Faculty or by the College and University policies, the Director or Chairman shall conduct a referendum, and report its results for confirmation by the Institute or Denartment Faculty.

ART. 3. Students enrolled as majors and in good standing, in academic programs of the Institute or Department may attend and narticipate in discussions of curricular matters: provided, that they shall have no voting right.

Section 7. Subject to the University Charter, the reorga.. nization of the College of Arts and Sciences in Diliman approved at the 377 th meeting of the Eoard of Regents on 30 September 1976, as amended, and all other previously adopted resolutions, policies, and rules pertaining to the organiza tion of the said College are hereby repealed.
