Alfonso, dated 5 September 1973 on 'Revised Rules 10 on Study Privileges of U P Personnel,' states that: 11 12 Personnel who are on vacation leave with pay 13 for the entire duration of the term enrolled in or on 14 study leave for the entire duration of the term shall 15 be entitled to reduced fees for the maximum 16 load of nine (9) units (graduate or undergraduate) 17 during any given term subject to the rules on study 18 load of the academic program or of the college 19 enrolled in. [Section C.2 of Alfonso memo. 20 underscoring supplied.] 21 22 Because of this provision, in some CUs, faculty on study 23 leave who enroll in more than nine (9) units are made to pay for 24 the excess units. It is therefore proposed that the 9-unit cap be 25 removed, provided that the study load is duly approved by the 26 graduate advisor and department chair 27 28 To make this privilege explicit, the following provisions in 29 the Rules for UP Faculty Receiving Full or Partial Load 30 Reductions for their Study Loads' (1053rd BOR meeting, 27 31 August 1992), under the section 'Privileges of Faculty Fellows 32 and those on Full Study Leaves,' are proposed for modification 33 as follows (words in CAPITAL LETTERS to be inserted): 34 35 Full Study Leave with Pay 36 37 Full deloading from regular faculty duties, full faculty 38 salary and other benefits for regular faculty in the 39 active service (including eligibility for promotions), 40 100% WAIVER OF TUITION, LABORATORY AND 41 MISCELLANEOUS FEES (EXCEPT STUDENT 42
