

Sec. 2. Powers

ART. 19. The Council shall have the following powers:

- a. To prescribe the courses of study and rules of discipline, subject to the approval of the Board of Regents;
- b. To fix the requirements for admission to any college or school of the University;
- c. To fix the requirements for graduation and the receiving of a degree;
- d. To recommend to the Board of Regents students or others to be recipients of degrees; and
- e. To exercise disciplinary power over the students, through its President or Executive Committee, within the limits prescribed by the rules of discipline approved by the Board of Regents.

Sec. 3. Officers

ART. 20. The President of the University System shall be the presiding officer of the University Council. In his absence, the Vice-President for Academic Affairs shall preside, and in the absence of both, any of the following officers in the order stated: Chancellor of the University of the Philippines at Los Banos, Vice-President for Development and Public Affairs, and Vice-President for Administration. ART. 21. The Registrar shall be the ex-officio Secretary of the Council. It shall be his duty to issue the notices for meetings of the Council, to keep the minutes of its proceedings, and to send a copy of such minutes to each member of the Council. He shall also forward to each member of the Council a copy of the order of business of every regular meeting at least three days in advance.
