ART. 75. Subject to the approval of the Council, each faculty has the power to determine the entrance requirements of the college and the courses of study to be pursued for each degree offered; to recommend to the Council qualified candidates for degrees, titles, and certificates; to administer the educational and internal life of the college System, within the limits prescribed by the rules of the University / and by the President; and to make recommendations to the Board of Regents, the University Council, or the Executive Committee through the President.

ART. 77. In coursing of all proposals for presentation to the University Council, the following procedure shall be followed:

a. The faculty or member of the Council shall submit his proposals to the President, through the Secretary of the Council;

b. The President in turn shall direct the Secretary to refer the proposals to the appropriate committee of the Council;

c. The committee shall report its action to the President, through the Secretary, for submission to the Council.

Sec. 2. The Dean or Director

ART. 78. For each college or school, there shall be a Dean or Director who shall be elected by the Board of Regents from the members of the faculty of the University unit concerned, or nomination by the President of the University System.

No faculty member newly appointed to or transferred from one unit to another shall be entitled to an appointment as dean of the second unit until after a year of satisfactory service as faculty member of that unit. However, in exceptional cases and upon recommendation of the President, this policy shall not apply to the external units. (792nd B/R, Feb. 25, 1970, as am. at 794th, B/R, Apr. 23, 1970).

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
