C. Categories of Extension Work: Based on the practice of various academic units, the following activities will be considered as extension work:

- Technical assistance to government agencies, non-government agencies, industry partners, people's organizations, other educational institutions, international organizations, and communities, specially marginalized and underserved communities (in the form of trainings, commissioned studies, members of technical panels of govt agencies, technical services)
- Extramural programs, e.g. Extension program of College of Music
- Service learning programs
- Organizing symposium, forum, conferences, exhibits, performances
- Advocacy and Community mobilizations
- Service to the University (without administrative load)
