D. Proposed creation of the position of "Adjunct Professor"

The "adjunct professor" designation shall be given to a recognized expert in his/her field who is not employed by the University and who is willing to devote part of his time to teaching and/or research in the University. He shall not receive compensation from the University.

The position of "adjunct professor" is in addition to the following categories of faculty members in the University:

- 1. "Clinical Assistant/Associate Professor" at the College of Medicine whose appointments are without compensation;
- 2. "Visiting Professor" is a designation given to a faculty member of another academic institution who is teaching in the University. The terms of employment depend on the memorandum of agreement by the University with executed the institution of the individual concerned or upon the terms of the invitation. Compensation will be on a case-to-case basis. Request for funding. should be made in advance however. by requesting unit for purposes of allocation of funds; and
- 3. "Affiliate Faculty" is a designation given to a staff of a U.P. unit who is tapped to teach a course in another U.P. unit and given teaching load credits in accordance with pertinent existing policies.
