22 **G. Establishment of "The Concepcion Dadufalza  
23 Award for Distinguished Achievement"**

25 Particulars:

27 A benevolent alumna of the University who  
28 requested anonymity and who simply wanted to be  
29 identified as "Friend of C.D. Dadufalza," offered to fund  
30 this award to honor a beloved and retired mentor, Prof  
31 Concepcion D. Dadufalza, on the occasion of her 50<sup>th</sup>  
32 year of teaching at the University of the Philippines.

34 1 The purpose of the award is to honor men/women  
35 of distinction, to keep alive the selfless vision and  
36 values that Prof Dadufalza embodies.

8 2. It will be given each year to an outstanding  
9 individual who has excelled in his/her professional  
10 life or who has contributed significantly to important  
11 causes in society. Anyone who has been affiliated  
12 with the UP as a student, faculty member,  
13 researcher or administrator can qualify as a  
14 recipient of the award.  
15  
16 3. The donation consists of P20,000 a year for the  
17 awardee, who will be asked to deliver a lecture on  
18 how he/she reaches out to accomplish praiseworthy  
19 undertakings, to be held in UP every February, with  
20 Prof Dadufalza as special guest. The donor has  
21 made a commitment to contribute to this award  
22 indefinitely during her lifetime and for her daughter  
23 to continue the contribution in her behalf after her  
24 death.

26 4. The lectures will be compiled and published every  
27 five years, with the donor underwriting the  
28 expenses.
