B. Establishment of a eystem of faculty ranks and qualifications whereby qualified reaearch and extension personnel may be appointed to the ranks of Assistant Professor (Research/Extension), Associate Professor (Research/Extension), and Professor (Research/Extension).

The proposed system of faculty ranks and qualifications shall be applicable System-wide.

Note: After a series of consultations by officials of the University with the staff of DBM, the latter had agreed to the appointment (or promotion) of qualified research and extension personnel as Assistant Professor (Research/ Extension), Associate Professor (Research/ Extension), and Professor (Research/Extension), as the case may be.

DBM requested in this connection that the University submit a formal decision or resolution by the Board establishing an appropriate system of faculty ranks and qualifications for research and extension personnel.

B-1. Conversion of the items of twenty-five REPS positions to faculty positions of U.P. Los Bafios, to facililate their promotion in accordance with the system of faculty ranks and qualifications proposed in B above. (Please see Appendix B for the list of REPS positions proposed to be converted.)

Appointment to the ranks of Assistant Professor (Research/Extension), Asscciate Professor (Research/ Extension), and Professor (Research/Extension) shall be subiect to the same qualifications standards as are prescribed for Assistant Professor, Associate Professor, and Professor as provided for in the Revised University Code, and such other requirements for research and extension specialists as the Board may prescribe.

## Mrice Requirement

Those appointed to the ranks of Assistant Professor (Research/Extension), Associate Professor (Research/ Ftension), and Professor (Research/Extension) will be Emuired to teach at least one course each year in the Hscipline of their specialization in any suitable teaching partment or unit of the University.

Pave Privileges
Those appointed to the ranks of Assistant Professor TResearch/Extension), Associate Professor (Research/ Axtension), and Professor (Research/Extension) shall continue to enjoy cumulative leave privileges; provided, that they shall be subject to the same leave rules and regulations those governing administrative personnel and other personnei (e.g., deans, department chairmen, college gecretaries, etc.) enjoying cumulative leave privileges.
