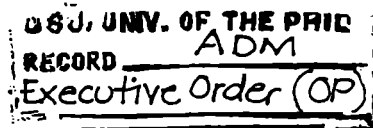

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 03

SUBJECT: Clarification on the Policy Concerning the Assignment of Teaching and Research Load to Professors Emeriti


The rank of Professor Emeritus is a title for life. In other words, once a faculty member is appointed as such, his/her appointment need not be renewed.

However, University Administration determines when and under what conditions a Professor Emeritus may be given by the Dean, subject to the approval of the Chancellor, an official assignment, including teaching and research.

In light of the foregoing, the University hereby issues the following clarification concerning the grant of teaching or research assignment to a professor emeritus:

A Professor emeritus may be given a teaching or research assignment by the Dean of a college, subject to approval by the Chancellor. No faculty member, including a professor emeritus, beyond seventy (70) years old shall be given any teaching or research assignment. However, if there is a need for the teaching services of a faculty which cannot be met by any regular faculty member or lecturer under age 70, a professor emeritus over 70 years old may be given a teaching assignment subject to the approval of the University President.
