9 **Computer Loan Program**

10
11 U.P. Diliman proposes to establish a Computer
12 Loan Program as part of capability enhancement
13 program for its faculty and staff.

14
15 Qualifications:

- 16
17 1. Full-time regular or temporary faculty and
18 permanent staff of the University.
19
20 2. Net take home pay must be sufficient for the
21 monthly installment through payroll deductions, i.e.
22 net pay after all deductions should be no less than
23 P2,000 per month, including PERA and ACA.
24
25 3. No pending loan application with all recognized
26 governmental and non-governmental providing
27 credit and lending services institutions (e.g. GSIS,
28 Provident Fund, Credit Union).
29
30 4. Established need for computer for capability
31 enhancement as certified by the Unit Head.

32
33 Amount of Loan: Maximum of P50,000.00

34
35 Options and Terms: Amount of loan inclusive of
36 interest shall be payable on equal monthly
37 installments, starting two months after the grant of
38 the loan, as follows:

11 A maximum loan of P50,000.00 for each borrower
12 will initially benefit 100 applicants. On the
13 third month after the grant of the loan, at
14 least 8 additional applicants will be benefited
15 if all loans are payable within 12 months (at
16 8% interest), while only additional 4
17 applicants will be benefited if loans are
18 payable in 24 months (at 9% interest).

20 Guidelines

21
22 Following are the implementing guidelines for **the**
23 **Computer Loan Program** of the University of the
24 Philippines Diliman:

- 25
26 1. The Computer Loan shall be granted on
27 priority basis to faculty and staff of the
28 University of the Philippines under the
29 following conditions:
30
31 a) That the applicant is a permanent
32 regular faculty or with temporary
33 appointment, or permanent non-
34 teaching staff of the University;

11 i. If faculty with temporary
12 appointment, he/she must
13 name as guarantor another
14 permanent faculty member
15 or permanent non-teaching
16 staff of the university with
17 the capacity to guarantee
18 payment of loan.

19
20 b) That he/she has served the University
21 for not less than one (1) year on
22 regular status; or if temporary, for at
23 least two years;

24
25 c) That there is an established need of a
26 computer for capability enhancement
27 of the applicant as certified by the
28 Head of the Unit;

29
30 d) That the proceeds of the loan shall be
31 solely for the purchase of a computer
32 unit and/or parts and peripherals
33 thereof;

34
35 e) The total amount of loan inclusive of
36 the prescribed interest shall be
37 deducted on equal monthly
38 installments from the pay of the
39 applicant starting two months after the
40 grant of the loan;

11 f) That no grantee shall avail of this
12 benefit within four years after the grant
13 of the loan; and

14
15 g) That grantee abides by the additional
16 guarantees contained in the
17 memo/letter of undertaking.

18
19 2. The University of the Philippines shall initially
20 set aside a self-sustaining fund of
21 **P5,000.000.00**, known as **The Computer**
22 **Loan Fund**, from available funds to finance
23 the **Computer Loan Program** on a
24 continuing basis;

25
26 3. Monthly collections from the beneficiaries of
27 the **Computer Loan Program** shall be
28 plowed back to the Fund to finance the
29 requirements of additional or new applicants;

30
31 4. The total amount of loan, inclusive of the
32 prescribed interest shall be payable in 12
33 months or 24 months as may be agreed by
34 the applicant and management.

35
36 5. The administration of the Computer Loan
37 program shall be the responsibility of the
38 **Vice-Chancellor for Administration**,
39 specifically the **Benefits Section** of the
40 **Human Resources Development Office**.

11 6. The Computer Loan Program takes effect
12 upon approval of the Board of Regents.

13
14 Procedure

- 15
16 1. Applicant fills out CLP application form, to
17 include certification by Head of Unit of
18 faculty/staff's need for a computer unit
- 19
20 2. Queues at **Benefits Section HRDO** for
21 priority list—specifying amount of target loan
- 22
23 3. Acquires certification/clearances of
24 qualification for benefit
- 25
26 a. Accounting – certification that net pay
27 is more than P2,000 per month,
28 factoring the amount of CLP loan
29 monthly payments
- 30
31 b. GSIS, Provident fund, Credit Union –
32 certifications of no pending loan
33 application/s
- 34
35 4. Goes back to HRDO to fill up Letter of
36 Undertaking, to be cleared by **Head of**
37 **Benefits, HRDO Director**, for notarization
38 and submission

11 5. HRDO to endorse application to Accounting
12 for voucher preparation

14 6. Voucher to be approved by HRDO Director
15 and the **Vice-Chancellor for Adminis-**
16 **tration**

18 7. Voucher goes back to **Accounting** for check
19 preparation
- 20
21 8. Vice-Chancellor for Administration signs
22 check, to be released by the **Cash Office**
- 23
24 9. Beneficiary must purchase the computer unit
25 not later than seven (7) calendar days after
26 release of check. Beneficiary must fill up
27 **Report of Purchase** within seven (7)
28 calendar days after purchase of unit and/or
29 parts, and submit original copy of **Official**
30 **Receipt** and photocopy, the latter to be
31 retained by HRDO for records purposes.
- 32
33 10. If the amount of loan is greater than actual
34 cost of computer unit, accessories or
35 components, the balance should be paid
36 back to the Cashier, who must issue a **GRP**
37 **Official Receipt.**

10 11. The **GRP Official Receipt** must be
11 presented to HRDO, who will retain a
12 photocopy of such.

15 **Board action: Approval. The**
16 **guideline which provides that**
17 **the applicant has no pending**
18 **administrative case as of the**
19 **actual date of the grant of the**
20 **loan was deleted as per**
21 **suggestion of Regent**
22 **Alfonso.**

25 **G-1. Realignment of funds from the reprogrammed**
26 **funds for the Housing Soft Loan Program to**
27 **U.P. Diliman faculty and staff (as approved by**
28 **the Board of Regents at its 1096th meeting on**
29 **23 April 1996) to finance the U.P. Diliman**
30 **Computer Loan program amounting to**
31 **P5,000,000, certified as available by the Chief**
32 **Accountant**

33
34 Note: It is understood that the disbursements
35 from this reprogrammed amount shall be
36 subject to the usual accounting and
37 auditing laws, rules and regulations.
