Matters recommended by the President ... (cont'd)

P. Proposal to prohibit (1) the use of UP's name by groups/organizations/centers conducting review classes for entrance/qualifying exams such as the UPCAT, LAE, NMAT; and (2) the use of UP facilities for this purpose

Justification:

There is a proliferation of groups/organizations/centers using UP's name or the acronym UP to advertise their review classes for entrance/qualifying exams such as the UPCAT, the LAE and the NMAT. Their advertisements tend to mislead the public who gets the impression that these review classes are sponsored by the University.

More appalling is when these review classes are conducted by UP faculty and staff using the facilities of the University. These not only mislead the public, but also give false hopes to examinees who might think that they will pass the entrance/qualifying exams because they paid for a UP-sponsored review class.
