

ART. 244. Any one enjoying student privileges shall be charged an amount equivalent to 25% of the fees for the courses in which he is enrolled rounded to the next higher five pesos (₱5.00). Permission to enroll in more than six units a semester may be granted depending on the individual merits of each case. The full rate of fee shall be applied to the units beyond the first six units.

ART. 244-a. Children and wife or husband of permanent full-time faculty members and of other full-time personnel, including those on daily wage basis, who have served continuously in their work for a period of not less than five (5) years, of the University proper, studying in the University of the Philippines, shall be exempted from the payment of tuition fees, provided said students passed a minimum of twelve (12) units or three-fourths of the total units he was enrolled in on the last day of late registration whichever of the two alternatives is higher, in the last semester attended. Chapter 25 Restrictions

ART. 245. No member of the faculty, officer or employee of the System University/shall publish or discuss publicly the proceedings of the Board of Regents or its decisions, not yet released for publication, without the written permission of the President.

ART. 246. No member of the faculty, officer, or employee of the System University/shall publish or discuss publicly any information concerning a particular college or school, not released for publication, without the written permission of its Dean or Director and the President.

ART. 247. No member of the faculty, officer, or employee shall publish or discuss publicly charges or complaints against any other member of the faculty, officer, or employee concerning his official duties

or his private life or conduct. Any such complaint or charge shall be addressed to the proper authorities of the University/^{System}for action before resorting to any other remedy available to the complaining party.

ART. 248. All information concerning a particular college or school shall be given by its Dean or Director; Provided, That the information has to do with his college or school only and not with any other college or school of the University/^{System}; Provided, further, That the President may prohibit the publication or the release of any news affecting the University System.

ART. 249. Authors of articles appearing in University/^{System}publications shall be severally responsible for the opinions expressed therein.

ART. 250. No member of the faculty, officer, or employee of the University shall, without permission from the President, practice any profession or manage personally any private enterprise which in any way may be affected by the functions of his office; nor shall he be directly financially interested in any contract with the University System unless permitted by the Board. Violation of this provision shall be punishable by reprimand, suspension, or dismissal from the service.

ART. 251. No dean of a college or director of a school in the University/^{System}shall, unless expressly authorized by the Board of Regents, accept other assignments involving administrative duties and responsibilities in other units of the University/^{System}or in any branch of the government service.

ART. 252. Permission to engage in private practice of the profession of faculty members may be granted only if such private practice may enhance their usefulness to the University/^{System}or improve their efficiency.
