

or his private life or conduct. Any such complaint or charge shall be addressed to the proper authorities of the University/<sup>System</sup>for action before resorting to any other remedy available to the complaining party.

ART. 248. All information concerning a particular college or school shall be given by its Dean or Director; Provided, That the information has to do with his college or school only and not with any other college or school of the University/<sup>System</sup>; Provided, further, That the President may prohibit the publication or the release of any news affecting the University System.

ART. 249. Authors of articles appearing in University/<sup>System</sup>publications shall be severally responsible for the opinions expressed therein.

ART. 250. No member of the faculty, officer, or employee of the University shall, without permission from the President, practice any profession or manage personally any private enterprise which in any way may be affected by the functions of his office; nor shall he be directly financially interested in any contract with the University System unless permitted by the Board. Violation of this provision shall be punishable by reprimand, suspension, or dismissal from the service.

ART. 251. No dean of a college or director of a school in the University/<sup>System</sup>shall, unless expressly authorized by the Board of Regents, accept other assignments involving administrative duties and responsibilities in other units of the University/<sup>System</sup>or in any branch of the government service.

ART. 252. Permission to engage in private practice of the profession of faculty members may be granted only if such private practice may enhance their usefulness to the University/<sup>System</sup>or improve their efficiency.
