

1.2 Waiver of the rules on secondment as amended by the Board at its 1031st meeting held on June 28, 1990 in favor of the following faculty members:

- a. Prof. Rafael Recto
- b. Prof. Mediadora Saniel
- c. Prof. Mary Ann Lansang
- d. Prof. Teresa H. Stuart
- e. Prof. Arturo Gomez

Board action:

a) Upon the suggestion of Regent Lazaro, the Board first amended the rules on secondment so that they should now read:

"2. Secondment to a policy determining, primarily confidential or highly technical position in the civil service may initially be for two calendar years, renewable for a like period; provided, that should the person seconded fail to return to the University after the expiration of four calendar years, the position in the University shall likewise be vacated ipso facto, provided further that, in the case of those seconded to the position of secretary or under-secretary in the executive, judiciary or legislative branch, two two-year renewals may be allowed; provided moreover that the second renewal may be allowed only if the faculty member resumes teaching in the University during such second renewal; provided finally, that

should a person seconded to the position of secretary or under-secretary fail to return to the University after the expiration of the six calendar years, the position in the University shall likewise be vacated ipso facto.

"IN VERY MERITORIOUS CASES, THE BOARD MAY, UPON RECOMMENDATION OF THE UNIT HEAD CONCERNED, THE DEAN AND PRESIDENT, WAIVE THE RULE ON THE NUMBER OF YEARS A FACULTY/STAFF MEMBER MAY BE ALLOWED TO BE ON SECONDMENT. IN NO CASE, HOWEVER, SHALL A FACULTY/STAFF MEMBER BE ALLOWED TO BE ON SECONDMENT FOR MORE THAN SIX (6) YEARS."

- b. The Board approved the extension of secondment of the following:
  - b.1 Prof. Rafael Recto - seconded to the National Orthopedics Hospital (NOH), as its Director for the period January 20, 1990 until May 31, 1992. (Approved secondment to NOH was from January 19, 1987 to January 19, 1990).
  - b.2 Prof. Mary Ann D. Lansang - seconded to the Research Institute of Tropical Medicine (RITM) as its Assistant Director for the period September 2, 1991 until May 31, 1992.
